To help you get the most from your visit, you may like to try some of these trips that can be done comfortably in a day.

North, South, East & West... Corowa is located in the “heart” of a wide range of interesting destinations all within 1-2 hours driving. Corowa is the perfect base for exploring this amazingly diverse region. A one day tour in any direction takes you to a completely different world with landscapes, culture & heritage that changes dramatically as the seasons.

Albury/Wodonga

Relax in the **Albury** Botanic Gardens which is sprawled over 4 hectares. View the exhibitions at the Regional Art Gallery. Visit Lake Hume for a spot of fishing or water skiing or marvel at the Hume Weir. Spend a day visiting the **Bandiana** Army Museum the largest and most diversified Military Museum in Australia. Shake off the dust and take a stroll around **Ettamogah** Pub & Sanctuary . Don't miss a visit to the Wonga Wetlands an ecosystem of lagoons and billabongs that are home to a stunning variety of wildlife.

Beechworth

One of Victoria's best preserved gold towns with the Burke Museum, one of the oldest in Australia with beginnings back to 1856. Visit the scenic gorge and waterfall, boutique wineries and the famous original Beechworth Bakery.

Benalla

Benalla's attractions are wide-ranging from gentle arts pursuits to action-packed sports and thrills. Wander the wineries or indulge in a leisurely lakeside gourmet lunch at the Benalla Art Gallery before viewing the Gallery's historic collection

Boorhaman

Enjoy a country drive to Boorhaman and then try an award winning beer at the Buffalo Brewery or enjoy a hearty country meal.

Bright/Mt Buffalo/Myrtleford

Enjoy the scenic drive on the Great Alpine Road through the Ovens Valley. Enjoy the Rail Trail Bike Path and the many lookouts in the area. Depending on the season marvel at the Autumn leaves, go bush walking, skiing or enjoy the fruit of the season. Don't miss the Alpine National Park and Mount Buffalo National Park.

Chiltern Box Ironbark National Park

Enjoy the walking trails and the local bird life, you may be lucky enough to see the Regent Honeyeater or the Turquoise Parrot - two of Victoria's most endangered birds. In Spring you can enjoy the wildflowers with spectacular grevilleas, lilies and pea bushes coming in to flower. The township has many historic buildings and the grapevine planted in 1867 which is recorded as the largest in the Southern Hemisphere

Glenrowan

See the Ned Kelly re-enactment theatre, visit Kate's Cottage Museum. Visit the Warby Ranges State Park & Wineries with cellar door tastings.

Holbrook

A rural town with picturesque parklands, bushwalks, historic buildings and the final resting place of HMAS Otway a 90m submarine.

Howlong

Visit the township of Howlong and follow the Historic trail of 28 locations in a 13.3km circuit. Pick up a self guided walking Map from the Corowa Visitor Information Centre or the Howlong Community Resource Centre. Howlong's 18 hole golf course is a pleasure to play, what ever the season.

Jindera

Take a step back in time at Wagner's Store & Pioneer Museum. Take a trip to Morgans Lookout and see the spectacular massive white granite stone formation there.

Lake Mulwala/Yarrowonga

Enjoy all that this beautiful lake has to offer. Fishing, boating, kayaking, lake cruises, water skiing or just relax on the shady foreshore area. Visit the Pioneer Museum, Clock Museum, Canning Art Gallery, Byramine Homestead, Linely Park, Jarden Aviation, Wineries or one of the many walking trails or relax at any of the three licensed Clubs.

Milawa Gourmet Region

The region is home to a number of leading wineries and gourmet food producers. Enjoy the cellar door tastings, Cheese Factory & Café at Brown Brothers. Pop into Milawa Mustards tasting room and café restaurant.
