DRAFT POLICY - SITING OF RELOCATABLE HOMES OR RIGID ANNEXES ON FLOOD LIABLE LAND

Notice is given that Council has prepared a draft policy to replace the current policy in relation to the Siting of Relocatable Homes or Rigid Annexes on Flood Liable Land within caravan parks. The draft policy is now on public exhibition and may be inspected at Council Shire Administration Office, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday to Friday inclusive.

Interested persons are invited to examine the draft policy and make comments or submissions concerning any aspect of the policy. Submissions or objections in writing will be received by the General Manager up until 5:00 pm on Friday 17 February 2012.

COROWA TIP

Due to legislative requirements and the reduced available waste disposal airspace at the tip, it has become necessary to ensure total compliance with Council's Environmental Licence.

To this end residents of Corowa Shire are advised that putrescible waste is not able to be disposed of at the Corowa landfill. Residents are asked to ensure that their waste is managed by ensuring that putrescibles waste is placed in their 240 litre MGB for weekly collection.

Also from this point on only waste generated from within Corowa Shire will be permitted to be deposited at the landfill. Victorian residents will no longer be able to utilise the tip. These restrictions will be enforced until the Transfer Station is operational.

RABBIT CONTROL

Corowa Shire Council will be undertaking rabbit control works from Monday 9 January 2012 to Tuesday 31 January 2012. The control will be undertaken with Pindone 25 Rabbit Bait laid in the following area:- **Mulwala Cemetery & Mulwala Water Treatment Plant**
