The Corowa Shire is a prospering rural community situated on Australia's greatest River the Majestic Murray in New South Wales, centrally located between the rural cities of Albury, Wodonga, Wangaratta, Wagga Wagga and Shepparton.

Boasting a Mediterranean climate, Corowa Shire has a vibrant atmosphere and is ideally located for business, families and retirees to experience exceptional lifestyle and opportunities. The Shire is only 3 hours from Melbourne, 4 hours from Canberra and 6 hours from Sydney.

The area population is 11,088 with Corowa at 5,596, Mulwala at 1,784, Howlong at 2,048 people plus many smaller villages through the Shire's rural area.

COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY

The Corowa Shire is home to a wide array of small to medium sized enterprises ranging from tourism and hospitality to manufacturing and agriculture. The major industries include a piggery feedlot and abattoir, agriculture machinery sales and services, food processors, munitions factory, many freight transport companies and thriving tourism, retail and trade businesses.

Tourism, accommodation and the registered club industry are major employers in the area. Tourism is a fast growing part of the region's economic expansion.

Transport and agricultural industries are also extensive throughout the Shire area. The region raises sheep, cattle and pig meat for export and large domestic contracts. The local transport industry has an excellent reputation and carts product throughout Australia.

Employment in the above industries is readily available throughout the region. There is a wide array of employment opportunities for labourers, tradesmen and service professionals throughout the Shire.

The Shire's total annual output is equivalent to \$1,183,183,000 and recent estimates show that there were more than 650 businesses operating within the Shire.

COROWA, a NSW Federation Town is serviced by a large array of specialty and variety stores, two supermarkets, Country Target and many old style pubs. Centrally located in the Shire, Corowa is the main service centre of the Shire, ideal for day trips and locally based activities. Industrial and commercial properties are available and reasonably priced with excellent transport links to all east Australian cities.

HOWLONG has a rapidly growing town centre with new stores and businesses, including a supermarket, chemist, post office, bakery, two pubs, a motel, Registered Club, 18 Hole Golf Course and 2 bowling greens. Development is booming in Howlong with new homes being built alongside historical buildings. Reasonably priced industrial and residential land is available only a short distance from Albury-Wodonga and the busy Hume Highway.

MULWALA Set on the edge of the picturesque Lake Mulwala, MULWALA is currently thriving due to the continuing surge in population growth. Many opportunities remain for the development of commerce and industry. The Melbourne Street commercial strip includes a butchery, bakery, post office, takeaway, Chinese and Italian restaurants, a supermarket, newsagency and petrol station, industrial and leisure businesses, 3 registered clubs plus a 45 hole golf course, the largest public course in the southern hemisphere.

EDUCATION

The Corowa Shire has a choice of public and private schools from pre-school through to Corowa High School. The Riverina Institute of TAFE, Riverina Community College and the University of the Third Age (U3A) are also located within Corowa. Both La Trobe and Charles Sturt Universities have facilities in nearby Albury/Wodonga.

HOUSING

The housing industry is continuing to experience strong demand in Corowa, Mulwala and Howlong. Land values in Corowa have grown an average of 14% over the last nine years and in Howlong during the same period 16%. Housing values have grown on average over the same period by 8% in Corowa annually and 10% Howlong annually.

Property prices are still reasonable and very attractive to the increasing number of 'C-Change' buyers who seek lifestyle allotments, a riverside/lakeside location or quality centrally located properties.

HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES

Corowa Shire is serviced by Greater Southern Area Health Service who provide excellent health care facilities to the people of the region.

Corowa has it's own Medical Centre employing over ten Doctors, a Hospital, new aged care facility along with Corowa Community Health who provide ancillary medical services throughout the Shire. There are several Chemists in Corowa.

Howlong is serviced by a Doctors Surgery located in the Community Health Centre. The township also has its own Chemist.

Two Medical Centres and a Hospital in Yarrawonga service Mulwala and district.

Corowa Shire residents also have access to comprehensive and specialised health services in near-by Albury/Wodonga and Wangaratta.

Childcare facilities are provided through Corowa Family Day Care, Childcare Centres in Corowa, Howlong and Yarrawonga/Mulwala.

HISTORY

Corowa is commonly referred to as the Birthplace of Federation due to its significant role in bringing about the Federation of the Australian Colonies. During the 1893 Corowa Conference organised by the Local Border Federation League, a motion put forward by Bendigo's Dr John Quick was unanimously carried. This motion had the effect of changing both the pace and direction of the Federation Movement in Australia. Visit Corowa's Federation Museum for more details on this historical event.

SPORTS AND LEISURE

The Shire is a sporting mecca catering for sports ranging from lawn bowls and golf to extreme sports such as skydiving, water skiing and professional boat racing. The shire is home of a world class lawn bowls facility, three championship golf courses which includes the largest public golf course in the Southern Hemisphere with 45 holes. The shire plays host to the Australian Billy Cart Championships and is home of the Australian Soaring Centre. Horse racing is also a big attraction and sports such as football, netball, tennis, hockey, rowing and cricket are catered for extensively.

The Shire is the central access point to the snowfield regions of Victoria and NSW as well as the famous wine regions of Rutherglen, King Valley and the Gourmet Region.

Residents and visitors to the Shire have the opportunity to explore the history which has made Corowa "The Birthplace of Federation" and enjoy the well preserved surrounds and those of the near-by Gold rush townships. Alternatively, activities may include Murray River or Lake side nature walks, bird watching or camping at one of the many lake and riverside Caravan Parks.

NOXIOUS WEEDS

Homeowners and tenants who occupy a premise have obligations and responsibilities to control noxious plants. Failures to take measures to control noxious plants may be liable to a penalty fine (not exceeding \$10,000).

PET REGISTRATION

Any cats & dogs that are sold or given away from 1 July 1999, must be micro chipped and lifetime registered. Existing cats and dogs must also be micro chipped and lifetime registered.

Animals can be micro chipped at a local veterinary surgery, or any animal welfare organisation. A pink Lifetime Identification form will be provided. This pink form, proof of de-sexing and any other documents that entitle you to a discount are to be provided to Council for registration to be completed. Assistance animals including guide dogs or working dogs are free.

To change registration details or to de-register a pet please forward a copy of your registration certificate from the Companion Animals Register with the changes to be made clearly marked on the form.

Council will then amend your details so they are correct and forward you a new certificate of registration.

SALEYARDS

Noon every Monday the local sheep and lamb sale occurs at Corowa saleyards.

Building & Development

DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL PROCESS

A **Development Application** is to be lodged to Council prior to building a house, shed, pergola or opening a business.

It is recommended to seek advice in the earliest instance from Council's Environmental Services Staff on the development requirements and regulation that may apply to the development.

Application forms are available from the Corowa Shire Council Offices in Corowa and Mulwala. The application should include three copies of the proposed work and site plans. Payment of an application fee applies as calculated based on the value of the development.

To construct a building a **Construction Certificate** will be necessary. This may be obtained from the Council or an accredited person.

A **Principal Certifying Authority** must be appointed, that is a qualified person to carry out inspections on the work and to certify compliance with relevant standards. This is usually the Council or a private contractor.

Council must be notified and receive the relevant forms two days before works commences.

If Council is the Principal Certifying Authority a number of inspections of the work will be carried out in order to issue a **Compliance Certificate**.

An **Occupation Certificate** is required prior to occupation or use of the building, which is granted by the Principal Certifying Authority.

SUBDIVISION

To subdivide land, a **Development Application** is to be lodged with Council. The application is assessed and subdivision takes place on Council approval.

Property ownership registration

Change of property ownership requires a letter advising Council of the change. Notification to the Rural Lands Protection Board is also advised.

Transport

Transportation within the Corowa Shire is predominately by road. The Riverina Highway threads its way through the Corowa Shire from Berrigan to Albury. The Murray Valley Highway (Victoria), 5 kms from Corowa links to the Riverina Highway at Corowa's Federation Bridge (2005) Murray River crossing via the Rutherglen-Wahgunyah Road. The Corowa Shire has access routes to the Hume Highway via the Murray Valley Highway through Howlong, and on the Development Road through Wangaratta. Both only 30 minutes travel by car.

Commercial air services are not scheduled for Corowa and are accessed via Albury Airport, however on occasions when Albury Airport is under fog, air services land in Corowa.

Public Bus services operate from Corowa to Albury from Monday to Friday picking up at Howlong, Wahgunyah, Rutherglen, Chiltern and Wodonga.

History

COROWA SHIRE

The Corowa Shire, formed under the Local Government Act, was gazetted on the 10th of June 1955, with the amalgamation of the NSW Municipality of Corowa and the Shire of Coreen.

The Municipality of Corowa was and gazetted on 19 June 1903 and the Shire of Coreen was gazetted on the 16th of May 1906. The Shire of Coreen included the township of Mulwala and the surrounding districts of Balldale, Buraja, Coreen, Daysdale, Lowesdale, Hopefield, Rennie, Savernake and Warragoon.

The region is steeped in history, playing a significant role in the 1901 Federation of Australia, boasting a historical 'man-made' lake vital to the irrigation of the Riverina Murray area and seeing the attempt of several overland services.

FEDERATION

The township of Corowa is often referred to as the 'Birthplace of Federation'. It was at a conference in Corowa in 1893 held by the Federation Leagues of Australia, that a resolution was passed paving the way for the eventual formation of the Australian Commonwealth.

Until the Corowa Federations League Conference the Federation Movement had been largely a political movement. However, following the passing in of the unanimous "peoples" motion to the Corowa Court House, the Federation Movement became a popular people's movement. This held ultimate significance and saw the beginning of the push for Federation by the people.

Finally after a lengthy process lasting 50 years, Queen Victoria proclaimed the Commonwealth of Australia and announced Federation was to be inaugurated on 1st of January, 1901.

LAKE MULWALA

People power also played a role in the development of Lake Mulwala in 1939. The River Murray Commission sought to create the Lake at Mulwala as irrigation water storage. The Commission were planning to fill the area without removing a considerable Red Gum forest, which as a result would become submerged.

The locals however had another vision for the area as more than just irrigation storage; they saw the opportunity to create a picturesque lake. As a result of considerable community spirit, local volunteers worked long hours felling the Red Gums by axe. The tree felling was complete in June 1939 and the Lake was first filled on the 12th of August of the same year. The local communities use the Lake for water sport and recreational activities.

HOWLONG

Towns throughout the Shire have their own unique histories. Howlong was the origin of the first overland cattle drive to South Australia, as well as claiming the first overland mail service between Port Phillip (Melbourne) and Sydney.

A 100-mile horse race was also run from Howlong. It is considered the longest horse race in the world.

HISTORIC BRIDGES

In addition, the township of Corowa is home to the John Foord Bridge. This bridge is a significant example of late-Colonial bridge design. The Bridge is the only one of its type of the 17 road bridges over the Riverina Murray between Albury and the South Australian border.

The bridge is one of 18 surviving British lattice truss type bridges in New South Wales, all designed by John A McDonald. They were the dominant group of large span bridges built between 1873-1983 and are among the most significant bridges of the Colonial period.

When completed in late 1892, the 3-span bridge was one of only four bridges across the River Murray and had a prosperous impact on inter-Colonial commerce and communications. It is the only bridge on the River Murray named after a pioneer settler – Mr. John Foord.

John Foord was a pioneering cattle overlander throughout the region. He was often thought of as an entrepreneur, making the most of the river trade and the gold rush at nearby Rutherglen. John Foord was a storekeeper, flour miller and transport operator owning two paddle steamers and a punt.

Additionally, he structured the townships of Wahgunyah on the Victorian side of the river and North Wahgunyah (now Corowa) on the New South Wales side of the river. John Foord was a prosperous and influential man, a worthy name sake for the 1892 bridge.

In more recent times a new river crossing has been built on the opposite side of Corowa. Federation Bridge was officially opened on 2nd April 2005.
