By completing the following entry form, you will be supplying the Corowa Pastoral, Agricultural & Horticultural Society Inc (CPAHS) with personal information without which we will not be able to administer your entry in the 2011 Corowa Show (the show).

- We collect this information for the purpose of administering the Show. This includes :
 - processing your entry
 - managing your entry in the relevant event
 - awarding prizes in the relevant event
 - assessing your compliance with the general regulations and conditions of entry, as well as other standards expected of participants in the show,
 - assessing any protests or appeals you might make
- We also collect this information for purposes related to the administration of the show including :
 - publication of winners details
 - maintenance of information relevant to qualifications for other events
 - maintenance of records of incidents that may occur at the show
 - providing insurance for you during the show, where applicable
 - making a claim on our insurance in relation to any incident or accident in connection with the show
 - Passing your information to the group of Show Societies and/or Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Inc (ASC) and /or Victorian Agricultural Societies Association Inc (VASA) should you be involved in Group or State competitions.

Unless you indicate your preference not to receive such material (see below), we may also use this information to update you on coming events to be run by the CPAHS, such as the 2011 Corowa Show.

We may disclose information about you to medical practitioners, St Johns Ambulance Officers and other health service providers attending the show. We may disclose information about you to the media for the purpose of publishing articles on your participation at the show. We may disclose information about you to the Equestrian Federation of Australia, ASC and VASA to assess your qualification and eligibility for other events. If legal, health or safety issues arise; we may be required to disclose information to relevant organisations who deal with these matters.

You have some rights to access personal information that we hold about you. Show Regulations

1. Each member of the Society whose subscription is paid will be entitled to admission to the ground for the member, one guest and two children. All members shall have the right of free parking.
2. All entries must be the complete work of the exhibitor. Fees must accompany all entries or the entry will be deemed to be not received.
3. Entries must be lodged with the Secretary as per deadline of each section but no later than Friday 7th October 2011 at 5pm. All entries must specify the class and section exhibits that are to be entered and any other information requested in the section.
4. **All exhibitors will pay admission charges to the ground.**
5. All exhibits must be bona-fide property of exhibitors at the time of entry. Exhibitors of stock will be required to furnish all particulars as to age and pedigree of each exhibit, the breeders' name (where name is known), and in the case of sheep, where same were last shorn, and any other information as the Committee may deem necessary including declarations. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any exhibit improperly entered, or regarding which a false statement has been made.
6. Should there be any reason to suspect that any exhibit is either diseased or dangerous or objectionable, the Committee reserves the right of removing same and refusing admittance to the show.
7. Exhibitors shall, under the direction of the steward, arrange their exhibits and no exhibit shall afterwards be removed or interfered with, without the sanction of the stewards, under a penalty not exceeding \$100.00. The Committee have the power to retain any such exhibit until the fine is paid.
8. The members of the Committee and the Stewards in the relevant sections shall, at any time, have the power to enter any space allotted to any exhibitor, and give such directions as regards to the exhibits as they think fit and any exhibitor refusing to carry out such instructions shall be disqualified, or suffer other penalty as the Committee may deem fit.
9. In all cases where there are at least three entries, the judge shall award two prizes unless, in his opinion, the exhibits are not worthy of the prizes. In such cases the judge shall be empowered to award one prize only, whether a First or Second, or he need not award a prize at all.
10. No exhibitor or agent shall be permitted to be with the stewards or judges during the time of judging, unless by special request of the stewards. No exhibitor shall be allowed to act as Judge in the section in which they exhibit. The exhibit of any person infringing this regulation shall be disqualified. This regulation will be strictly enforced.
11. Damage Through Exhibits – The Society will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused through, or by, an exhibit and it will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Society blameless and indemnified against legal proceedings arising from any such accident. The Society will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, damage to, or misdelivery of any exhibits.
12. Loss By Disease – The entry form will be taken as guarantee that the animals specified therein are free from disease, so far as is known to the owner. In the case of infectious disease being spread through or by an exhibit, the exhibitor shall be held responsible.
13. Fire – Precautions will be taken to guard against fire, and to protect the property of the Show, but exhibits will not be insured at the cost of the Society.
14. PROTESTS – ALL protests must be lodged with the Secretary, addressed to "The Secretary", and accompanied by a deposit of ten dollars (\$10) not later than 4pm on the day of the Show. If the protest is considered frivolous by the Committee, the deposit may be forfeited. In hearing of all protests and disputes arising out of an award, the Committee shall abide by the Judges' book, unless it be shown that the Judges have been willfully or accidentally misled.
15. The Committee will select Judges and Stewards for all sections, and fill any subsequent vacancies.
16. NO exhibitor or attendant will be permitted: to make unseemly noises that may be considered a nuisance in calling the attention of visitors to their exhibits; to distribute any advertising cards or other notices, considered immoral, objectionable, or in any way infringing the privileges disposed of by the Committee. Any exhibitor or attendant found guilty of such behaviour shall forfeit their space and all other privileges, and shall be removed from the Show Grounds.
17. If any person willfully injures or destroys any property within the Show Grounds of the Society, he or she will be prosecuted and dealt with as the law directs.
18. Pavilion Exhibits – All Pavilion Exhibits must be entered with the Secretary prior to the 10th October 2011. Late entries may or may not be accepted and will depend on the discretion of the Committee.
19. No exhibitor passes will be issued.
